- Use of cooperative contracts reduces the cost of goods and services by aggregating the purchasing power of public agencies nationwide.
- All contracts are awarded by a government entity utilizing industry best practices, processes and procedures.
- Can be used by any non federal government agency or Non-Profit entity

- Public participants who are part of the Omnia Partners contract have competitively solicited pricing from vendors
- Public sector entities offer a Request for Proposal and publicly award contracts for the best value to vendors who participate in the fixed price cooperative pricing program
